BEYOND THE CALL DE PERE POLICE OFFICER AWARD

Criteria:

I. NOMINATIONS:

All nominations for the Beyond the Call Police Officer Award must be submitted to the award committee consisting of the De Pere service/civic clubs through the Chief of Police. All police officers are eligible for the award. Nominations must be forwarded to the Chief of Police for duty performed from January 1st through December 31st of the preceding year. The BEYOND THE CALL PLOICE AWARD RECOMMENDATION FORM must be utilized and must include a narrative signed by the person detailing the acts. All documentation, pictures, testimonials or reports should accompany the form. Nominations may not be considered without the submission of a narrative regarding the event or services rendered by the nominee.

The nominator may be asked to attend the meeting of the service clubs' Awards Selection Team to provide a brief overview of the incident and answer any questions the team may have.

II. AWARD CRITERIA:

Nominations may be made to recognize individuals for performance in any of the following areas (keeping in mind that safety should not have been unnecessarily compromised to affect the act, unless the potential benefit exceeded the actual/perceived risk):

- An act of exceptionally meritorious conduct involving exemplary courage, great risk, and danger to personal safety and/or directly responsible for saving a human life.
- Meritorious service in the performance of an assignment of great responsibility.
- Performing admirably, beyond normal job duties. Outstanding response to an unusual situation.
- Performed efficient and valuable service to the department; either in carrying out a specific task or in the performance of general duties over an extended period of time.
- Unusual/unique assigned job duties.
- Long-term commitment to the citizens of De Pere (seniority).
- Outstanding leadership.
- Outstanding interaction with citizens.
